Admission Information

Thank you for your interest in Providence Christian School. We consider it our privilege and honor to serve you.

At Providence Christian School, our goal is to provide a quality education in a Christian environment that develops the entire person and produces young people with both the desire and ability to serve God, family, and others. By developing a strong partnership with parents, Providence Christian School is able to help families bring to fruition the intellectual and spiritual potential that God has bestowed upon their children. That partnership begins with the admission process.

The admissions process is designed to ensure a student's readiness and potential for having a successful and rewarding experience at Providence Christian School and to determine proper academic placement. Providence Christian School does not have the facilities or the personnel to effectively work with extreme emotional or behavioral difficulties or with students with acute academic deficiencies. Students will be expected to demonstrate a genuine interest in pursuing their education in harmony with the standards and purposes of Providence Christian School.

Admission Policies

General:

Providence Christian School does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, gender, or national and ethnic origin. Due to high demand for placement and high re-enrollment rates at Providence Christian School, students may be placed on a waiting list. Placement of students on the waiting list is based on the date of application, priority status, completion of the admission process and acceptance. Parents will be notified of their status on the waiting list.

Financial Aid:

A student must be accepted for admission before applying for financial aid. Please contact the school office for information regarding financial aid or other financial matters.

Age Requirements:

It is required that kindergarten applicants be five years of age on or before September 1st of the enrollment year. If your child turns six by September 1st, you may wish to consider applying for first grade. **Any variance from the above age requirements must be approved by the school administrator and superintendent.*

Admission Process

Admissions Open House:

You are cordially invited to visit the school. The school sponsors three Admission Open Houses, two in the fall and one in the winter. Please call the school office for details and to confirm dates.

In addition to the school's Open Houses, parents/guardians are welcome to schedule a private school tour and to visit our classrooms on an individual basis.

Application Procedure:

1. The admission process begins with the completion and submission of the Enrollment Application, along with the non-refundable application fee (\$150).
2. Prospective students must complete admission screening and a classroom observation to be considered for enrollment. The screening must be scheduled within 30 days of application. Admission screening is conducted by ABC Tutoring and Educational Services, Inc. Parents need to complete a screening application form and mail it with the \$67.00 screening fee to ABC Tutoring and Educational Services. ABC Tutoring will contact each family to schedule the screening. Results of the screening will be reported to Providence Christian School. If the initial screening does not provide a clear assessment, the school may require additional testing. The classroom observation can be scheduled by contacting the school office.
3. Parents of students who have attended a previous school will need to request the release of records to Providence Christian School.
4. Upon notification of acceptance to Providence Christian School, a parent interview with the school administrator or appropriate school personnel is scheduled. Registration will be finalized with the completion and submission of the Tuition Contract along with the non-refundable registration fee (\$500). At this time, parents will also need to provide a copy of the following: birth certificate, Social Security card, Kindergarten Health Assessment (or a copy of the immunization record for older children).
