

PTF Board Meeting Minutes
February 5, 2008

The PTF Board of Providence Christian School met on January 8th to review needs for the Holy Smoke BBQ. Junior Achievement and Field Day

Topics Discussed:

1. Jim Lovell has a list of the items needed to make 1000 dinners. Donna Moore reviewed the various businesses she was talking to for donations. Some of these donations will be goods (such as plates, napkins, and cutlery), other donations will be monetary. There have been 2 donations of \$1000 each. A pamphlet has been created to solicit donations. Businesses contacted include Costco and Lowe's Food. Debbie Scott volunteered to check Sam's Club. Michelle Davis has a contact at corporate Harris Teeter. Jim Lovell will contact Food Lion as there are parents at the school who work in various departments there. Board members suggested contacting Brixx Pizza, Pet Milk, Chick-fil-A and Izzy's as they are suppliers of our school lunches. Paige Hicks volunteered to check with Pannera Bread and Monterey's.
2. Dr Dallas discussed sponsorship of the Jog/Trike -a-thons. A packet will go home with each student. There will be 10 tickets for sale. School dismissal will be at 4:30 on the day of the BBQ.
3. Dr Dallas noted that this year, there will be office delivery of BBQ. There is a minimum order of 10 plates. Drivers will be needed.
4. Lindalee Davis had forms for committee heads to assist with organizing volunteers. Jim Lovell again encouraged everyone to contact last year's chairs to facilitate organizing the various events.
5. Donna Moore reported that she had contacted the Charlotte Knights about using their mascot, Homer. Debbie Scott reported that Sir Purr from the Panthers will be available in the afternoon.

6. Jim Lovell asked if anyone had either found a replacement for their board position or was discussing it with someone. Some board members had asked people, but there had been no confirmations at this time.
7. Field Day will be May 28th. Michelle Davis reminded the board that they are responsible for organizing the activities. Jim Lovell noted that early in the year he and Dr Dallas (Dr Dallas had left the meeting at this time) had discussed letting Cathryn Walling lead this. There are many parent volunteers for Field Day, so "staffing" it should not be an issue. Jim will discuss this further with Dr Dallas.
8. Laura Willis reported that there were volunteers for all grade levels and Junior Achievement was underway.
9. Because the BBQ is less than 3 months away, the Board will meet more frequently. The next meeting will be on February 26th at 8 AM.
